(THE LOOTINGS OF RICE AND PADDY ENQUIRY (AMNESTY) ACT, 1947.)

[BURMA ACT NO. LXXIII OF 1947.]

Rangoon, the 26th November 1947.

No. 473.- The following Act is published for general information:-

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

THE LOOTINGS OF RICE AND PADDY ENQUIRY (AMNESTY) ACT, 1947.

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force from the 15th July 1947, and shall remain in force until such date as the Governor may by notification declare it to be no longer in force.
2. The Lootings of Rice and Paddy Enquiry Committee means the Committee that has been appointed by the Governor of Burma by a Resolution in the Agriculture and Rural Economy Department, dated the 3rd July 1947, as subsequently amended.
3. No proceedings shall be instituted in any Criminal or Civil Court in Burma against any person in respect of any evidence, written or oral, given by him to or before the Lootings of Rice and Paddy Enquiry Committee.
4. No statement, oral or written, made by any person before or to the Lootings of Rice and Paddy Enquiry Committee shall be admissible in evidence against him in any suit or proceeding.

In the name of His Majesty I assent to this Act.
